

Tirunelveli District – Press release on Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System (IFHRMS)

Sensitisation cum Training meeting on Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System (IFHRMS) for the Government Employees is being conducted from 28.05.2018 onwards and this training programme was reviewed by **Thiru. Tenkasi S Jawahar, IAS, the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai** and **Tmt .Shilpa Prabhakar Sathish I.A.S., District Collector, Tirunelveli District** at Tirunelveli on 29.05.2018.

Thiru.Tenkasi S Jawahar, IAS, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai has stated the following.

1. Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System (IFHRMS):

The Government have proposed to implement Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System (IFHRMS). The existing Automated Treasury Bill Passing System (ATBPS), Web Pay roll and e-pension software will be integrated in this scheme. The Government have accorded sanction for Rs.288.91 crore as project cost towards the implementation of the IFHRMS. For implementation of this project, a private company has been selected as System Integrator (SI). At present, the development of the software and infrastructures required in the project locations are being made ready.

On implementation of the Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System Project, about 29000 Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDOs) throughout the State will be able to submit the bills to the Treasury online. This System will provide real time data on revenue and expenditure. The public will also benefit with hassle-free and instantaneous services. This system will also pave the way for smooth maintenance of Service Register of all Government employees on real time basis by which the employee's pay bill, promotion, transfer, leave etc., are managed online. The Integrated Financial and Human Resource Management System will have security features like bio-metric authentication, digital signature etc., This new system is expected to be rolled out by October 2018. This will enable Government to know the real time fund position which will strengthen the Finance and Human Resource Management.

Under this scheme, the Service Registers of about 9 lakh Government Servants are being digitized. The employee's pay details, promotion, transfer, leave and other service details are updated on real time basis then and there.

The service history of a Government servant right from entry into Government Service till the retirement is being digitized under this scheme.

The officials maintaining the Service Registers can be freed physically from the SR maintenance work and involved in other productive duties of the department. The time spent in transmitting the Service Register from one location to another can be saved. Besides, there won't be any dislocation of any Service Registers. Since the Service Records are updated in the system regularly, immediate action can be taken and pensionary benefits can be paid without any unnecessary delay and also reduce the possibility of fraud/misappropriation. The system based records can be utilized by the Government for Human Resources related review and planning. Postings and transfer decisions can be taken by easily accessing the authenticated service particulars available in the system. Service Registers of 46044 Nos. Government servants in Tirunelveli district are being digitized.

For successful implementation of the scheme, four days training under this scheme has been planned to certain DDOs of all Departments and additional two days training will be given to Treasury Officials. Subsequently, training will be given for remaining DDOs. The Training covers preparation of Salary and Non Salary bills, e-Service Register Maintenance, Preparation of Pension Proposals etc., for all Government Departments and Bill Passing, Strong Room Maintenance, Stamp Management, e-office, Pension Disbursements etc., for Treasury Officials.

2. Services to the Pensioners

About 6,60,000 pensioners out of about 7,39,000 are being paid by the Treasuries in the State. Further, Government of TamilNadu has ordered that about 79,000 pensioners now drawing pension from Public Sector Bank Scheme (PSB) shall get the same through the Pilot scheme operated by the Treasuries and Accounts Department.

Protecting the interest and wellbeing of the Senior citizens is the primary duty. Hence, this department is taking speedy action to disburse the pension benefits in time. The First Pension to the new pensioners, Additional Pension for those who have completed 80 years and the restoration of commuted value of pension orders are being issued promptly.

Under Pensioners New Health Insurance Scheme, 726 Hospitals were already empaneled. Now it has been enhanced to 805 Hospitals. In this scheme, the facility of cashless treatment has now been extended not only to District Head Quarters hospitals but also to Taluk Head Quarters Hospitals. On account of the above step, the pensioners and their spouse can take medical treatment from the nearest hospitals. So far, 1, 90,502 persons have availed medical treatments for a sum of Rs.549.03crores.

3. Pensioners Mustering

Around 7.39 lakh pensioners are drawing pension at Treasuries in the state. Every pensioner shall furnish his/her life certificate to the concerned Treasuries in every year during 1st April to 30th June. This mustering process will be administered at 270 locations viz 31 District Treasuries and 238 Sub-Treasuries and the Pension Pay Office at Chennai.

During this year, 30193 out of 37336 Pensioners have been mustered at the District Treasury and 13 Sub-Treasuries at Tirunelveli District so far.

An additional facility has been provided during this year to the pensioners to submit their digital life certificate through "JEEVAN PRAMAAN" portal. This facility is provided by e-seva centers in the state. The Digital Life Certificates can be submitted by the pensioners through e-seva centers near their residence under JEEVAN PRAMAAN scheme. Further, if net-connectivity and finger print reader is available, Life Certificates can be submitted by the pensioners using this portal from anywhere in the world. This will save time and avoid hardships faced in their advanced age.

4. Pensioners Identity Card

The Government have issued orders in G.O.Ms.No.87 Finance (Pension) Dept dated 10.04.2017, to provide identity cards to the TamilNadu Government pensioners. Based on this Government Order, Identity cards are being issued to the

Pensioners/Family Pensioners on payment of Rs.30/- through 539 Govt e-service centres all over the State.

5. Public Sector BankScheme:

As per G.O.Ms.268 Finance (Pension) Department dt.18/09/2017, about 79,000 pensioners who are drawing their pension through Public Sector Banks will now get their pension through Treasury Pilot scheme. By this system of payment, as the bankers are sometimes not conversant with the process involving fixation/revision of pension, pensioners will now be able to get their dues easily.

6.Salary andPension:

Further, during the financial year 2017-18, salaries and pension to the tune of Rs1774.81 croreandRs.1167.76crore have been disbursed to the Government Employees and Pensioners respectivelyinTirunelveliDistrict.Further, during this financial year, Government receipts to the tune of Rs.5074.13crore have been transacted through the District Treasury and13 SubTreasuries.
